



Posture of the World Changer October 31, 2021 Discussion Notes

Questions:

1. Icebreaker question: What was one of your most embarrassing moments? What happened?
2. The sermon was based on Daniel 4 and the story of the humbling of Nebuchadnezzar. What do you remember about each of the main points?
3. What stood out to you or impacted you?
4. Read John 13:30-38
 - a) According to Jesus, why would God glorify the Son?
 - b) What "posture" were the disciples to take toward each other? (Also see John 13:5, 14). How would this posture affect the world?
 - c) How would you describe Peter's posture as seen in vv. 37-38?
5. Read John 18:15-17, 25-27
 - a) Why do you think Peter's predictions of his own bravery failed so badly? (see Proverbs 16:18 and 1 Corinthians 10:12)
 - b) How do you think you would have done in Peter's situation?
 - c) Are there ways in which you tend to hide your relationship with Christ from public view? What did Jesus teach about this (see Matthew 5:14-16)?
6. Read John 21:14-19
 - a) What is the significance of Jesus questioning Peter three times?
 - b) What does Jesus instruct Peter to do three times? In what way is this a redirection of Peter's focus?
 - c) What good would come from Peter's eventual death?
 - d) How does this passage relate to the points in the sermon outline?
7. Which of the points from the outline do you think you need to grow in the most?
8. Spend some time praying that God would help you to have the right posture before Him and before the people of this world. And pray for any needs in your Life Group.
