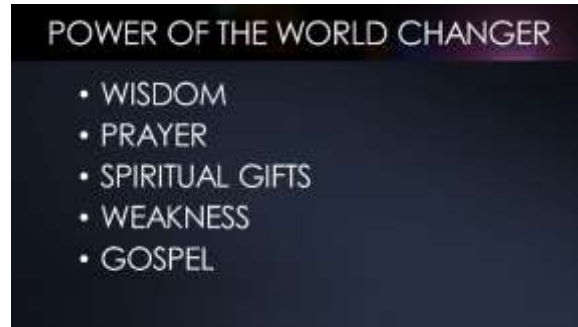
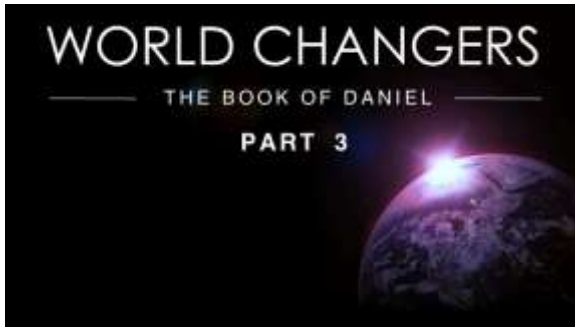


Power of the World Changer October 10, 2021 Discussion Notes

Questions:

1. Icebreaker question: What is a skill you have that most people don't know about?
2. The sermon was based on Daniel 2 and focused on the power God supplies His people with to make an impact in the world. What do you remember about each of the main points?
3. What impressed you most about Daniel in this story?
4. **Wisdom.** Read 1 Kings 3:5-14
 - a) If God made you the offer in v. 5, what do you think you would ask for?
 - b) What did Solomon ask for?
 - c) Why do you think God was pleased with Solomon's request?
5. **Prayer.** Read James 5:16-18
 - a) What does this passage of Scripture teach about prayer?
 - b) Do you believe that your prayers are powerful? Why or why not?
6. **Spiritual Gifts.** Read 1 Corinthians 14:1-5
 - a) What should our attitude be concerning spiritual gifts?
 - b) Why is the gift of prophecy considered superior to the gift of tongues?
 - c) What is prophecy designed to do for people? (see v. 3)
 - d) What is the purpose of all spiritual gifts? (see v. 5)
7. **Weakness.** Read 1 Corinthians 1:26-29
 - a) What did God choose?
 - b) What is His purpose in this?
8. **Gospel.** Read Acts 10:39-48 (where Peter is preaching to the family and friends of a Roman centurion named Cornelius)
 - a) What good news did Peter share with these Gentiles?
 - b) What happened as a result?
 - c) What does this tell you about the gospel?
9. How can each of these "power tools" help us to be better world changers?
10. Pray for each other's needs. Ask God to empower you with the Holy Spirit and with everything you need to be an effective world changer.
