


Ephesians Part 8 - Loved

March 27, 2022 Discussion Notes

(Phone apps are good for reading together in the same translation. Study Bibles give help with interpretation.)



Questions:

1. Icebreaker question: If you're married, how did you meet your spouse? If you're single, do you have a favorite love story (maybe from a book or movie)? What makes it special to you?
2. The sermon focused on knowing the unknowable love of God. What do you remember about each of the main points? What stood out to you or impacted you?
3. Read Psalm 139:1-18
 - a) List the number of ways that God thinks about you
 - b) Are you aware from day to day that God thinks of you like this?
 - c) How well do you follow God's example of thoughtfulness toward others?
4. Read Romans 8:35-39. How powerful is God's love for you? How have you seen this?
5. Read Hosea 1:1-3 and Hosea 3:1-3.
 - a) What must this have been like for Hosea? Why would God have Hosea do such a thing?
 - b) What does this tell us about God's faithfulness in his love for us? How has he shown this?
 - c) Are you willing to show this kind of faithful love toward unfaithful people in your life?
6. Read Luke 7:36-47.
 - a) In what ways were this woman's actions costly to her? Why was she willing to pay this cost?
 - b) How much has God forgiven you? How has this affected the level of your love for Him?
 - c) In what ways has God's love changed your life for the better?
 - d) In what ways is your love changing other people's lives for the better?
7. Spend some time in prayer. Thank God for His incredible love. Ask Him to help you to understand and embrace it better. Pray for unbelievers in your lives, that God's love would break through to them.
