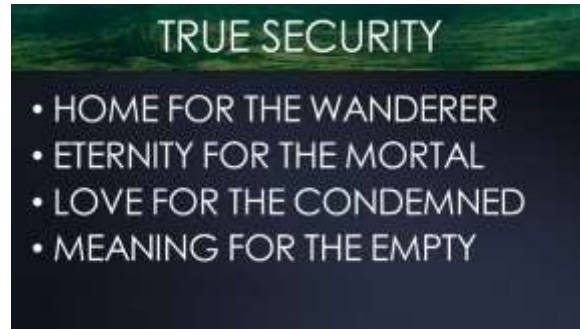
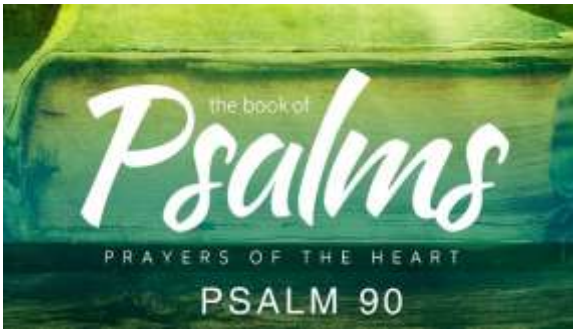


## Psalm 90 – True Security

#### Questions:

1. Icebreaker question: Can you remember a time when you were growing up when you didn't feel safe? What happened?
2. The sermon was based on Psalm 90, a prayer of Moses. What do you remember about each of the main points? What stood out to you?
3. Read 2 Kings 6:13-23.
  - a) Why was Elisha's servant afraid?
  - b) How did Elisha pray and what was the result?
  - c) There is a theme of blindness in this story. Why do you think that is?
  - d) How did Elisha treat his enemies?
  - e) In what areas do you feel insecure or unsafe?
  - f) If God opened your eyes like He did for Elisha's servant, what do you think you would see?
4. Read Luke 12:22-34
  - a) According to Jesus, what should we not worry about?
  - b) What situations bring out the worrier in you?
  - c) When have you seen God meeting your needs?
  - d) How can a person seek God's kingdom?
  - e) How can we store up treasure in heaven?
  - f) What do you think the Jesus means in verse 32?
5. Read Habakkuk 3:17-19
  - a) What trouble was Habakkuk envisioning?
  - b) What was he resolved to do?
  - c) How do you think he was able to do this?
  - d) How can Christians maintain this same attitude today?
6. Pray for each other's needs. Pray that God would give you eyes to see the security you have in Him. Pray for those in the world who are not experiencing God's safety right now.
