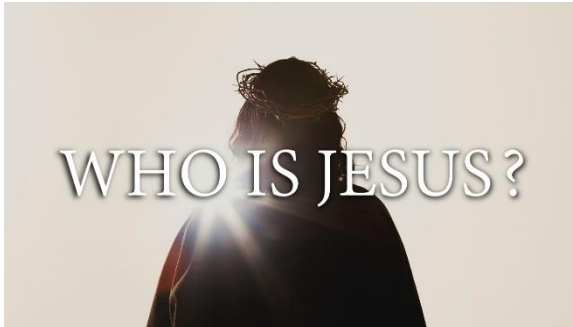


Who Is Jesus: The King of the Kingdom

Questions:

1. Have you ever met a famous person? What was that like?
2. How does it strike you that the King of kings invites you into a personal relationship with him?
3. The sermon looked at the nature of the kingdom of God. What stood out to you? Do you have any questions to bring up?
4. Read Matthew 13:44-46
 - a) What two or three expensive items do you wish you could afford?
 - b) What does Jesus liken the kingdom of heaven to in these parables?
 - c) What do you think his message is?
 - d) Have you had to give anything up for the sake of the kingdom? How difficult was it? Are you glad now?
5. Read Revelation 3:14-22
 - a) We just celebrated Palm Sunday and the Triumphal Entry of Jesus into Jerusalem. What entry did Jesus want to make in this passage in Revelation?
 - b) How does Jesus describe the church in Laodicea?
 - c) What does a "lukewarm" Christian act like?
 - d) What does it mean that Jesus "stands at the door and knocks"? (Note that these words are often used in evangelism, but they were first spoken to a church of Christians).
 - e) What areas of your life does Jesus need to be granted access to?
6. How can you honor Jesus as King this week?
7. Now spend some time praying for each other. Invite Jesus to be king in your lives. Ask him to reveal his might in the world today.
